How to Set Up Your Personal Operator Service

Establishing your Personal Operator number

Your Personal Operator number is the local ten-digit telephone number to which callers are transferred if they press zero while listening to your mailbox greeting. After you have set up your mailbox through the .New Subscriber Tutorial, you must establish your Personal Operator Number.

1. Dial the Voice Messaging access number 859-291-1234.
2. From the Main Menu:
 - Press 2 2 6 2.
 - Enter your ten-digit Personal Operator number and press #.
 - Enter 1 1 to activate your Personal Operator service.
 - Enter 1 2 to deactivate your Personal Operator service.

Making Changes to Your Personal Operator Service

How to activate and deactivate your Personal Operator service

From the Main Menu:

Press 2 2 6 1.

Enter 1 to activate your Personal Operator service.

Enter 2 to deactivate your Personal Operator service.

How to change your Personal Operator number

You may change your Personal Operator number at any time.

From the Main Menu:

Press 2 2 6 2.

Enter your new ten-digit Personal Operator number and press #.

Enter 1 1 to activate your Personal Operator service.

Enter 1 2 to deactivate your Personal Operator service.

If you experience difficulties changing your Personal Operator number, call the Voice Messaging Help Line at 513-397-0900 and press 0 after the instructions begin. Our Help Line service representatives will assist you in setting up your service to transfer callers to your new telephone number.
